



IN HIM

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus. Ephesians 2:4-6 (NKJV)

The key to being and remaining “in” Him is surrender, laying down our lives and giving over to His love, as He fills us with His Spirit.

We enter into new levels of understanding and revelation, and experience the supernatural realm of the Spirit. We hear His voice, sense His lead, and experience greater joy, healing, and hope for the future.

Our position *in Him* is a decision that is lived out in our daily walk, as we lean into and obey the Spirit, denying the pulls of our flesh (carnality). It is the difference between experiencing the fruit of the Spirit, or the frustration of trying to do life our own way.

In this season as we pray and read the scriptures, let us ask the Holy Spirit to amplify what it really means to be *in Him*. Let’s ask Him to help us understand how we intentionally choose to live from that position every day by faith in His word, and all that is true of who we are as His born again, Spirit filled children.

Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. 2 Peter 1:2-4 (NKJV)
